LESSON STRUCTURE

- 1. Introduction to Splash and River, the lessons interactive guides!
- 2. Baths: Avoid slipping by always sitting down in the bath. Don'f forget to empty the bath after, and to always be supervised by an adult.
- 3. Paddling Pools: Avoid being rough with others. Always have an adult nearby.
- 4. Outside: Stay away from barrels. Rivers and ponds can be very dangerous.
- 5. Stay away from troughs, you could fall in. Avoid slurry pits and watch out for holes.

- 6. Rivers: Never get in after balls, they are a lot less valuable than you. Stay away from edges (S.A.F.E). Rivers flow very fast.
- Swimming Pools: Walk slow, never run. Always listen to grown ups and lifeguards. Stay in the shallow end. Don't push/shove.
- 8. Beach Safety: Know the flags. What does each flag mean? Don't go out too far, waist depth is best. Always listen to lifeguards.
- 9. Floatation: How to identify ringbouys. Discuss function. Always wear a lifejacket if boating.
- 10. S.A.F.E Stay away from edges
