- 8. Beach Safety: List and explain the list of rules on page 11. More comprehensive list than before.
- 9. Beach Safety: Know what the flags mean.
- 10. Beach Safety: Explain the power of waves, and what to do if you get into trouble, especially what to do in a rip current.
- 11. Life-jackets and boats: Explain the importance of life-jackets and when you should wear them. Also some information on boat safety.
- 12. Quarries: List and explain rules, Pg 15
- 13. Know what the different signs mean.
